



Fall & Spring Outdoor Education Internship

Mount Pisgah Arboretum is a small non-profit located near Eugene and Springfield between the banks of the Coast Fork of the Willamette and the slopes of Mount Pisgah. Our mission is to engage people with nature through interactive learning and stewardship. We are looking for students who would like to gain experience in outdoor education.



Outdoor Education Interns develop understanding of local ecology and lead small groups of elementary aged children in nature-based outdoor lessons. All Interns work alongside the Education Manager and fellow Arboretum staff and are provided training opportunities before leading lessons.

Interns receive a stipend of \$16 per hour and work 13-20 hours per week throughout our fall (Sep - Nov) and spring (Mar - May) field trip seasons.



Fall & Spring Internship

Learning Outcomes for Interns include:

- Receive mentorship and training from Arboretum staff, gain experience in environmental education, local ecology, group communication, natural resources, non-profit management and more.
- Attend training days and shadow opportunities for the trip season.
- After training, independently lead 2 hour field trips based on the provided curriculum and nature-based topics.
- Aid in Fall Mushroom Festival and Spring Wildflower Festival, including event set up, public engagement, and kids activities.
- Co-lead weekend family or adult programs alongside Arboretum staff, with opportunities to create and modify lessons.
- Assist with on-site trail & stewardship opportunities.
- Organize and upkeep education materials.
